



Greenhouse Gases (GHG) Policy

When a comparison is made between the different production methods of animal proteins, the seafood industry in general and the pelagic fishing in particular can be considered an industry with a relatively low carbon footprint. The pelagic fisheries sector is in the position to contribute to minimizing climate change, while at the same time being a producer and provider of animal protein for a growing global population.

In our CSR policy we formulated our goal to reduce our carbon footprint per kilo fish. We have sharpened our goal as part of our GHG policy and commit to lowering our annual emissions of greenhouse gases per kilo fish and seafood products we produce. Carbon dioxide is just one of the six greenhouse gases listed in the Kyoto Protocol, although by far the most important gas emitted through human activities. This GHG policy covers the other gases as well, as far as they are relevant in terms of emissions caused by activities of PP Group (hydrofluorocarbons, perfluoro carbons and sulphur hexafluoride).

PP Group continuously looks for ways to increase our energy efficiency and to reduce our emission of greenhouse gases. Some of our initiatives are the following:

- We have set up a data collection framework to measure the amount of greenhouse gases we emit each year. In phase 1 (starting 2021) we focus on tier 1 and 2 and in phase 2 (beginning in 2030) on tier 3;
- We also monitor and reduce emissions as far as reasonably achievable through different initiatives (energy efficiency, R&D) (tier 1,2 and 3);

This GHG policy is subject to independent periodic audits. PP Group reports in a transparent manner on the results of our GHG goals and this policy.
